MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD TO FINALISE THE ANNUAL CALENDER FOR TRAINING & COMPETITION (ACTC) OF BOXING DISCIPLINE FOR THE YEAR 2018-19.

The meeting to finalise the ACTC 2018-19 for Boxing Discipline was held on 05th July, 2018 at 5:00 PM under the Chairmanship of Shri Rahul Bhatnagar, Secretary Sports, MYA&S in his Meeting Chamber at Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.

- Secretary (Sports) at the outset welcomed the members. 1.
- Col. Abhai Jawa, OSD, TEAMS, SAI started the meeting with reference of previous ACTC meeting held on 25th May, 2018 wherein the entire proposal submitted by BFI was discussed in detail which was of around 70 crores and as per the recommendation of Secretary (Sports) it was requested to BFI for limiting the budget to 50 Crores.
- Secretary (Sports) showed his concern regarding the revised ACTC Proposal of 51 Crores by BFI on which President, BFI & Executive Director, BFI gave explanation stating that the budget has spiked as BFI has requested for Equipment's costing around 10 Crores for all SAI Centres, for which Secretary Sports has suggested that the Equipment's pertaining to Boxing and are consumables are to be procured under ACTC and rest to be procured under SAI Block Grant or through Khelo India as the equipment proposed are part of Infrastructure and can't be justified under ACTC scheme.
- President, BFI presented the Annual Calendar of Training and Competitions (ACTC) for the year 2018-2019 in respect of Elite, Youth and Junior Boxers for Rs. 6300/- lakh. He stated 4. that although standard of Boxing has gone high and all 4 boxers in each weight category give one another tough fight and we can expect good result from boxing in the Asian Games 2018.
- The ACTC submitted by Boxing Federation of India (BFI) discussed in detailed and following decisions have been taken: -

v. International Competition where team will participate in India:

As per the NSF Norms only Rs. 30 Lakhs is permissible for conducting any International Tournament in Country, in this regard only Rs. 30,00,000/- is approved in ACTC 2018-19 for organizing International Competition in India, detail is placed as Annexure: 1

vi. Weekly Fight Nights: -

The committee approved the Weekly competition, stating that BFI will have to submit a detailed quarterly report for these competition and maybe treated this as a sparring partner project and can also be used to include/exclude players from camp i.e., result, progress etc, detail is placed as Annexure: 1

#### Highlight:

International Boxing Academy & Zonal academies:

- The Federation is exploring places to set up its International Boxing Academy including converting the National Boxing Academy, Rohtak into International Boxing Academy. Further, BFI also agreed to exposure possibilities of setting up AIBA International Boxing Academy at SAI Shooting range Tuglakabad where ample land may be available. BFI would visit place and submit plan & report of same.
- BFI was advised for setting up 08 Zonal Boxing Academies integrated with Khelo India Schemes at the earliest so that the Youth & Junior Campers category boxers could be based here wherein their education can also be taken care of, detail is placed as Annexure: 1
- vii. Coaches & Support Staff for providing training at National Camps for Seniors only (Male & Female Separately): -

a) Foreign Coaches: -

As Mr. Satiago is promoted to Chief National Coach his salary is to be increased by USD 1000 and Salary of Mr. Raffaele Begamasco to remain Same and all other perks to remain same for both the foreign coaches as per their contracts, detail is placed as Annexure: 1

  - c) Support Staff: -
  - The committee recommended that the compensation for the support staff to be made as per SAI Norms, and not as per the recommendation given by BFI, detail is placed as **Annexure: 2**

#### Highlights:

#### Foreign, Indian Coaches & Support Staff:

- The Secretary (Sports) asked BFI to propose a Chief National Coach, in this regard Name of Mr. Santiago Nieva current (High Performance Director) Boxing was unanimously accepted.
- As Name of Mr. Santiago Nieva was agreed for Chief Coach an increment of USD 1000 is to be made accordingly in his salary, i.e., USD 8000 per month.
- In view of the Camps requirement, BFI has submitted the list of coach's panel, the list was distinguished categorical, i.e., justifying their <u>Qualification</u>, <u>Experience</u>, <u>Salaries etc.</u>, as asked earlier.
- The committee recommended that the compensation for the coach's and Support Staff to be made as per SAI Norms, and not as per the recommendation given by BFI, detail is placed as Annexure: 2



#### Part C - Equipment's and Consumables

- The Secretary (Sports) while discussing the procurement of Equipment's and Consumables in Boxing Discipline for the Financial 2018-19 mentioned and suggested that the equipment's & consumables which are Boxing Specific are only to be procured under ACTC and rest of the equipment's which are basically Infrastructural products and need permanent installation at SAI Centers for which the Federation is asked to send a separate proposal to SAI.
- However, the need was found genuine and very important for better sports training for which Secretary (Sports) advised SAI to up this matter & follow up Under other schemes dedicated i.e., SAI BLOCK GRANT or by Khelo India Funds for updated non consumable goods such a medical, & scientific Equipment and other infrastructural goods.
- On these terms the following Equipment's and Consumables are approved under ACTC for Boxing Discipline for Financial Year 2018-19, placed as Annexure: 3
- BFI to submit proposal for installing the non-consumables Scientific & medical equipment's to SAI so that it could be considered to be procured for installation by concerned division at different SAI National coaching camp centres.

In conclusion observing all above facts, Secretary (Sports) approved for allotting budget of Approx. Rs.46.79 Crores in the discipline of Boxing for the year 2018-19, placed as **Annexure:**
