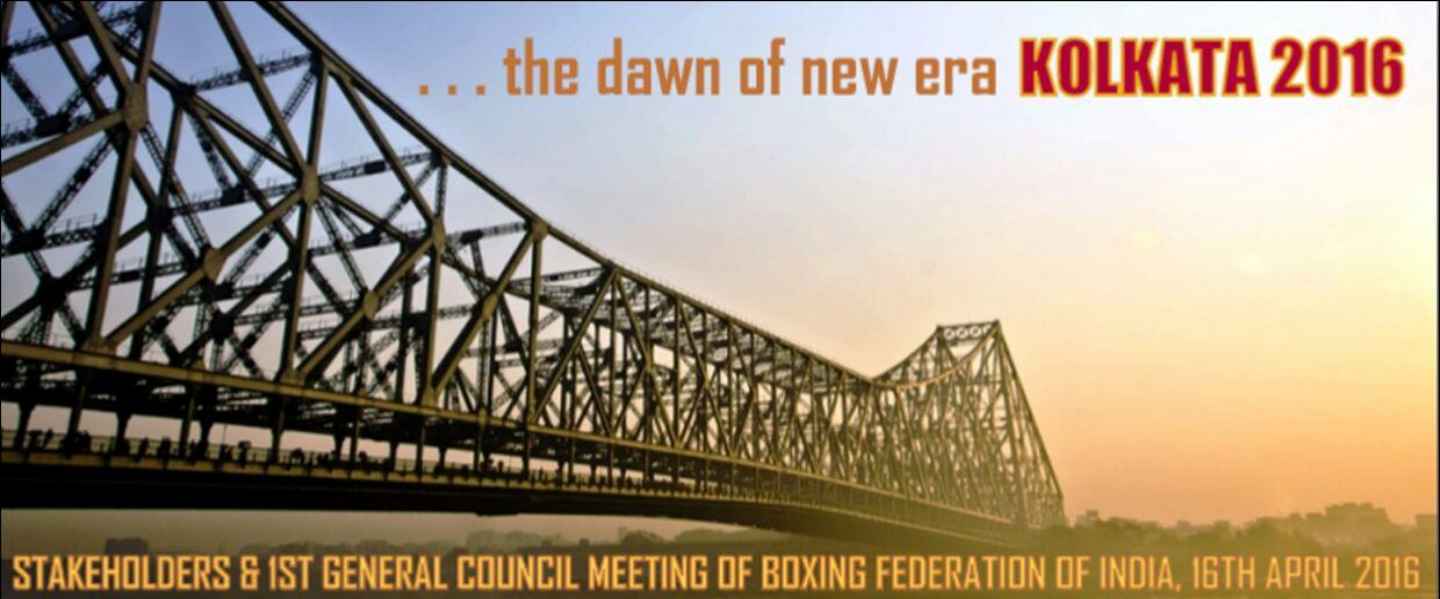

I thank Mumbai and Maharashtra's Boxing Community who have come forward to assist the boxing community to elect its first Executive Council and to get the stalled operations going.

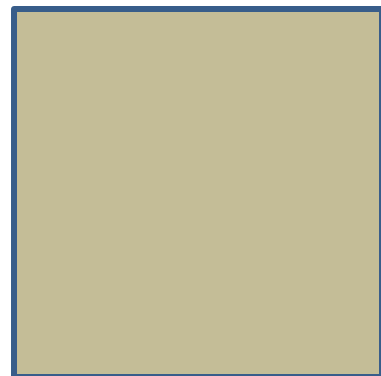

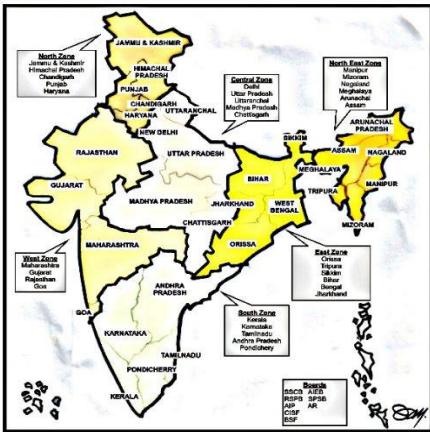


# REFORMS : 8 Zones enabling greater participation & grass root percolation of Boxing activities right across all parts of India equally

## Earlier Indian Boxing had 6 zones !

### Dis-advantages :

1. Areas : too large to commute
2. Needed 3 days to conduct Zonal Meets
3. Problem of 6 entries at Interzonal Nationals



## Now think of 8 zones !

### Advantages :

1. Areas : Small & compact - Easy to Commute
2. Need only 2 days to conduct Zonals - Sat/Sunday
3. 8 Entries : QF / SF / Finals at Interzonal Nationals
4. Opportunity for more Boxers to reach Nat'l level : 8 or 16 teams . . . than 6 or 12 teams !

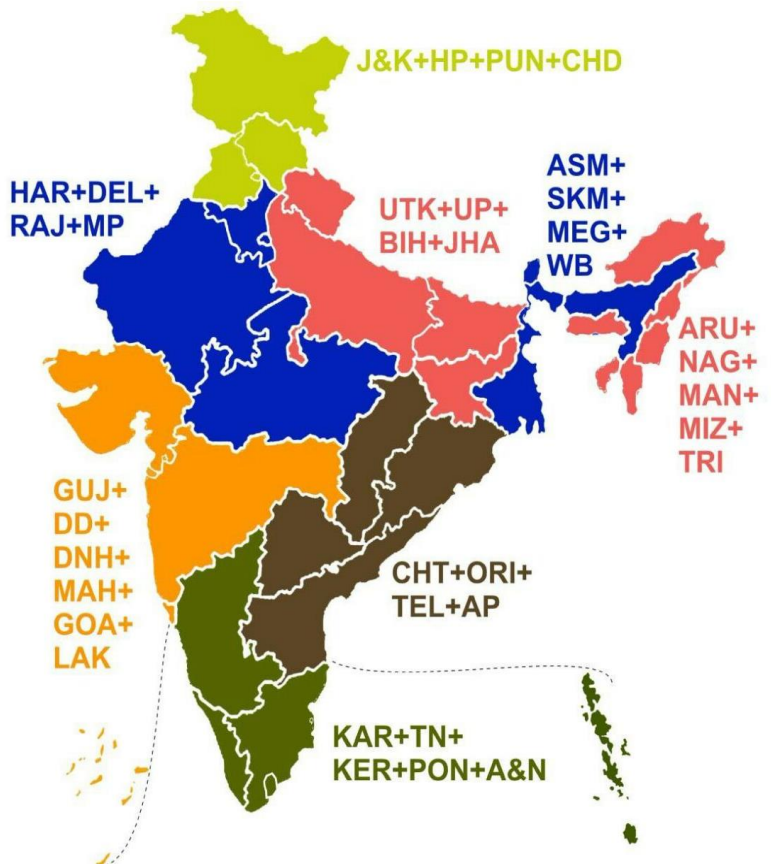
## नये मुक्केबाजी महासंघ में खिलाड़ियों का प्रतिनिधित्व होगा

नयी दिल्ली (भाषा) : भारत में प्रस्तावित नये मुक्केबाजी महासंघ में पहली बार मौजूदा और पूर्व मुक्केबाजों का प्रतिनिधित्व होगा, जिन्हें अगले महीने नये अधिकारियों के लिये होने वाले चुनाव के बाद कार्यकारी समिति में शामिल किया जायेगा। भारतीय मुक्केबाजी महासंघ (बीएफआई) के 14 मई तक नया रूप लेने की उम्मीद है, यह अंतिम तारीख अंतराष्ट्रीय मुक्केबाजी संघ (एआईबीए) ने नये महासंघ के गठन के लिये निर्धारित की है, जिसमें असफल होने पर देश के मुक्केबाजों को रियो डि जेनेरियो में खेलने के लिए भाग लेने से



महिला को चुनाव के जरिये चुना जायेगा। सभी संन्यास ले चुके मुक्केबाजों को एथलीट आयोग के जरिये पंजीकृत करने के बाद ऐसा किया जायेगा। सक्रिय सदस्यों को राष्ट्रीय चैम्पियनशिप के दौरान चुना जायेगा जो बीएफआई के कार्यभार संभालने के बाद आयोजित की जायेंगी। अधिकारी ने कहा, "चैम्पियनशिप में भाग लेने वाले सभी मुक्केबाजों को अपनी पसंद से मत मिलेगा। चुने गये मुक्केबाज कार्यकारी समिति का हिस्सा होंगे और महासंघ द्वारा लिये जाने वाले प्रत्येक फैसले में अपनी बात रखेंगे।"

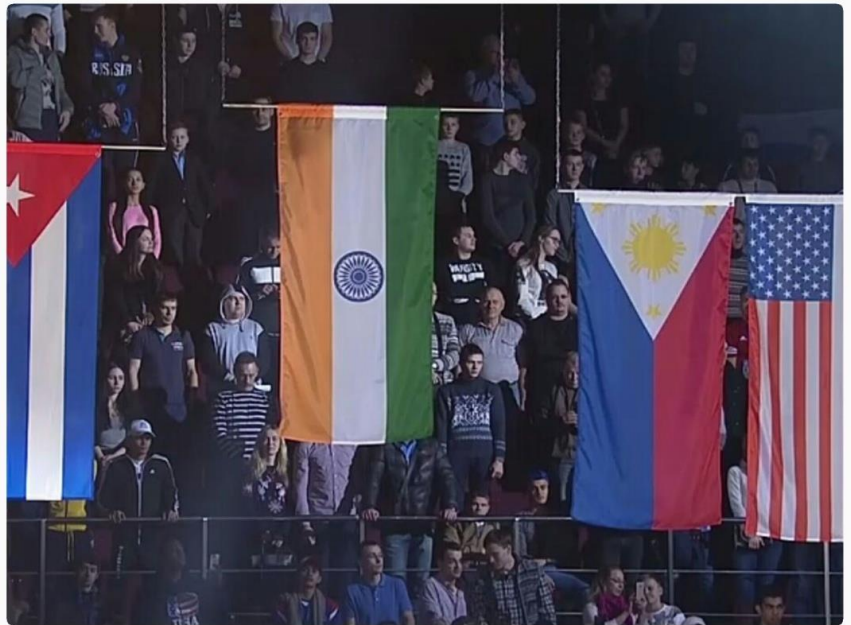

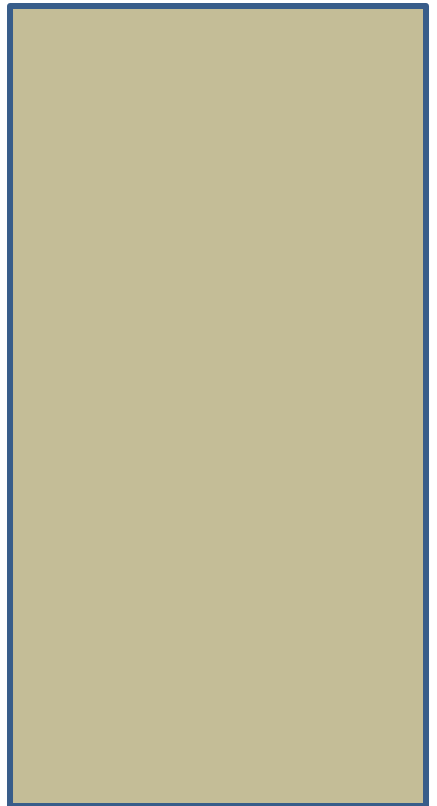
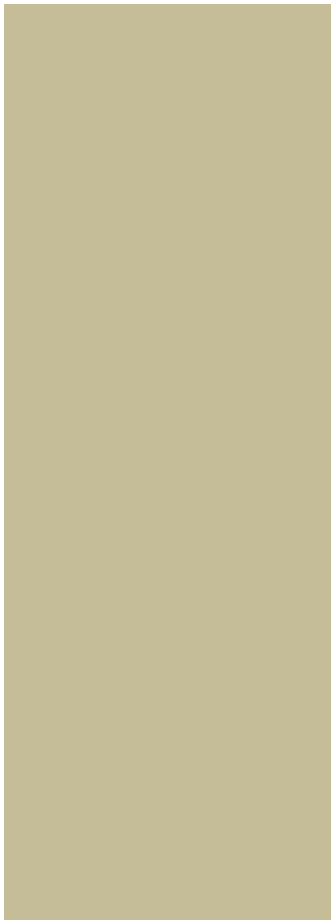
- **6<sup>th</sup> Nations Cup Boxing Tournament for Elite Women held at Vrbas, Serbia from 10-15 January, 2017**

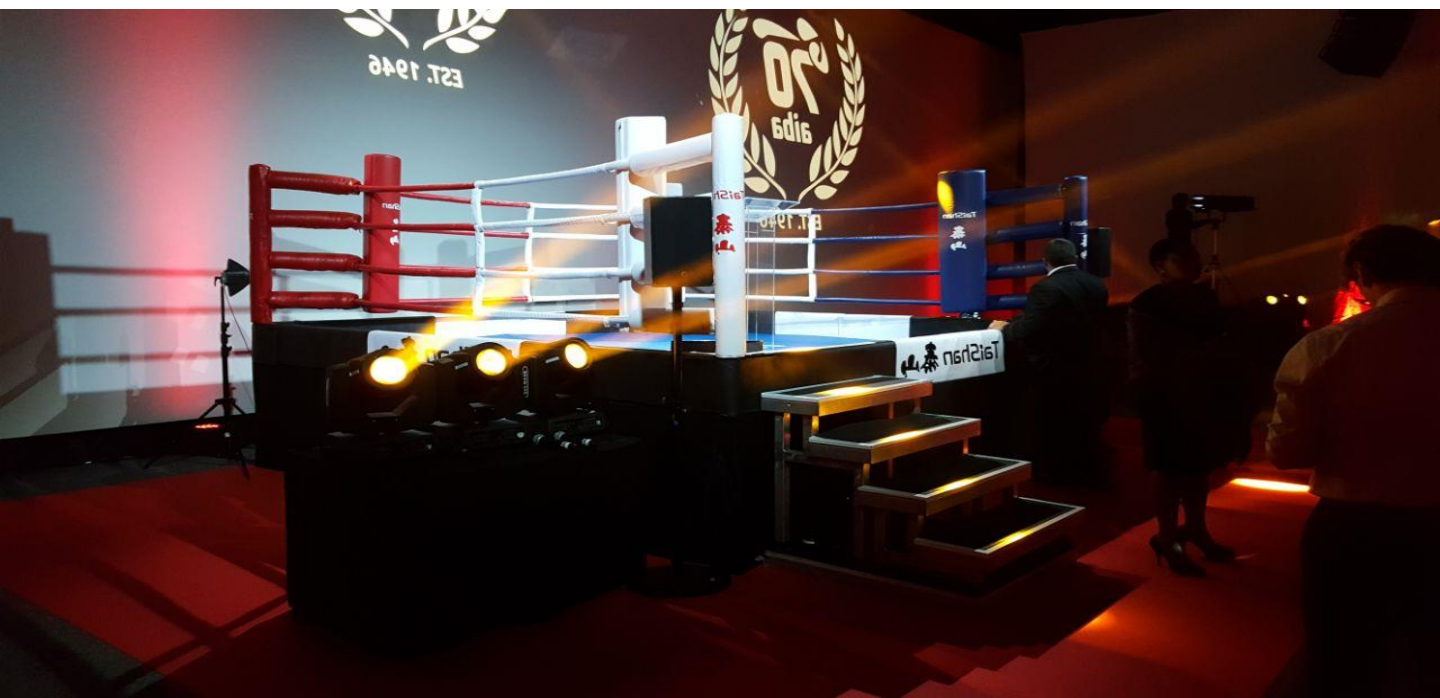
