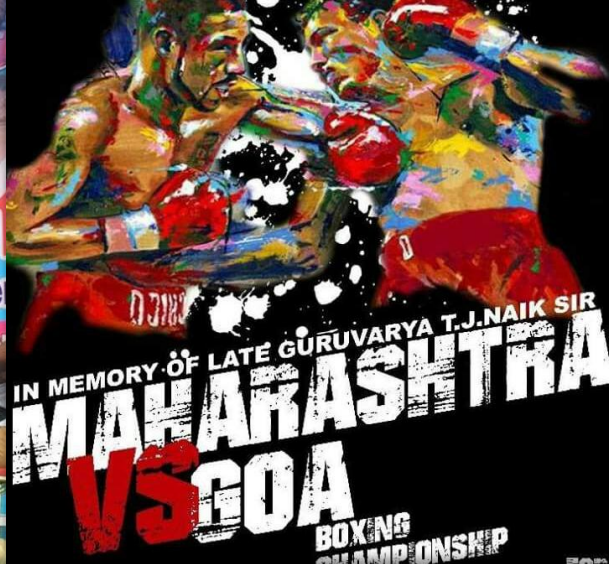

# India in WSB Ring

- AIBA awarded a WSB team, **Indian Tigers** to Boxing Federation of India for 3 years - 2018, 2019 and 2020. WSB boasts 12 franchises from three continents Americas, Asia and Europe bringing the best boxing nations to compete for international franchises.
- Team **Indian Tigers** of Boxing Federation of India participated in WSB for the 1st time. Indian Tigers played 3 home and 3 away matches vs teams from Kazakhstan, Russia and China. Team Indian finished 7<sup>th</sup> among the 12 teams. This stint provided good opportunity and exposure to our boxers.
- 2019 WSB will be the Olympic Qualification Event which will give chance to Indian Boxers to secure a berth at Tokyo Olympics 2020.

17 Boxers from WSB season 2015 qualified for Rio Olympics 2016. These qualified boxers were also allowed to participate in Continental and World Boxing Championships.
