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
4. Sanction 9 of FC (R) Act, 1976, provides inter-alia that no member of a legislature, office bearers of a political party, Judge, Government Servant or employee of any Corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above Act, he / she should obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before his / her departure to **Budapest, Hungary**.
5. Such of the team members who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (which include deputation abroad) in respect of this participation by the Department / Office in which they are employed in terms of Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt. (Pay-I) dated 30.01.1989. The Federation should inform their employing Department / Office accordingly.
6. It is requested that Embassy of India, **Budapest, Hungary** and organizers of the event may please be informed by fax / e-mail of the travel plans and itinerary of the team for participation in the above events. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of view.
7. Before departure, a report on dope test of the team members may please be obtained from DG, NADA, New Delhi.
