

## Introduction

Boxing Federation of India in association with Sports Authority of India is conducting the 4 Zonal Open Open Boxing Championships and 1 Combined Zonal Open Boxing Championship for holistic development of Junior & Youth Boxers in the country. The aim of this Open Zonal Championship is to identify and help recognize the talent at Junior and Youth level in the country.

**The States/UTs have been grouped into 4 Zones as mentioned below:**

## **Format of Zonal Open Championship**

**Junior Girls:** From each Group/Zone  $13 \times 4 = 52$  boxers in each Group will be selected for the Combined Open Championship. Thus, the total number of boxers so selected will be 208

**Youth Women:** From each Group/Zone  $12 \times 4 = 48$  boxers in each Group will be selected for the Combined Open Championship. Thus, the total number of boxers so selected will be 192

## **Format of Open Combined Zonal Championship**

On this basis about 208 Junior girls boxers and 192 Youth Women Boxers will be eligible to participate in the Combined Open Zonal Championship. In the Combined Open Zonal Championship, the bouts will be held on knock out basis.

## **Registration & Fees**

Registration and entry of boxers will be done by the Boxer himself on the given registration link. A fee of Rs. 500 per boxer will be paid to Boxing Federation of India.

<b>Weight Class Youth Women</b>	(45-48kg // 50kg// 52kg// 54kg// 57kg// 60kg// 63kg// 66kg// 70kg// 75kg// 81kg// 81+kg//
<b>Competition Format</b>	<b>For Youth Women:</b> Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, One (1) minute rest between rounds. IBA's 10 points must scoring system shall be followed.  <b>For Junior Girls:</b> Three (3) rounds of Two (2) minutes, One (1) minute rest between rounds. IBA's 10 points must scoring system shall be followed.
<b>Eligibility for Junior Girls</b>	<b>Boxers between the age of 15 and 16 according to their year of birth (born during the year 1st January, 2006 - 31st December, 2007) are eligible.</b>
<b>Eligibility for Youth Women</b>	<b>Boxers between the age of 17 and 18 according to their year of birth (born during the year 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2004- 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2005) are eligible.</b>

Entries will be accepted only after the registration on the given link.

All Boxers must have their Original birth Certificate, Aadhar card & Medical Book. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate and Aadhar card must be submitted at the time of Initial weigh-in and medical examination. All boxers must comply before registration, with age verification test report as per NCAFS norms and formats.

<b>Medical &amp; Weigh-in</b>	Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the venue from 0600-0700 hrs <u>for those boxers who are drawn to box on the respective days</u> from 16 <sup>th</sup> September to 22 <sup>nd</sup> September 2022.
<b>Draw</b>	<b>Draw will be held on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at 5:00 pm.</b>
<b>Team officials</b>	The participating teams are entitled to bring three (3) coaches at their own expenses.
<b>Dress</b>	Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or shoes minus spikes and without heel, shorts not exceeding knee length and a vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the colour of the Corner. Where vests and Shorts are of the same colour, the Belt line must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waist band 10 Cm wide of contrasting color.
<b>Boarding/Lodging (For Boxers And coaches)</b>	All the boxers & coaches have to manage their own Lodging & Boarding.
<b>Boarding/Lodging (For Technical Officials)</b>	Technical Officials are only entitled for the Boarding and Lodging from Host.
<b>Arrival particular</b>	All the boxers & Team Officials have to manage their own transportation. To & Fro to the place of stay to competition venue.
<b>Conveyance</b>	Transport will only be available for Technical officials to and fro the place of stay to venue of the championship and back.
<b>Registration</b>	The entry will be done by boxer himself by visiting the given registration link.
<b>NTO &amp; RJ's</b>	NTO's and RJ's will be appointed by Boxing Federation of India

### Additional Guidelines

1. To and Fro cost of travel to Guwahati and back as well as place of stay to competition venue of the Team / Team Officials will be the responsibility of Individuals.
2. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield (not of red or partially red color), Pubic Protector and breast protector may be worn if needed.
3. For the first Weigh-in, the Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor be below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
4. No type of body piercing and body accessories is allowed to be worn during the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
5. Boxers must carry their Medical Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate, Aadhar Card and Original copy of Age Verification Report from the School for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose.
6. **"Age Estimation Certificate"** for all participating boxers conducted at a Government Hospital as per SAI Norms is needed to be submitted during medical examination.
7. All boxers must carry a recent Hepatitis B, C and HIV test certificate. (last 3 months validity)
8. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit BFI's Annual Medical Fitness Certificate. (Last 12 months validity)
9. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves, head guards and hand bandages to all the boxers for their respective bouts.
10. The Championship will be conducted as per IBA / BFI Competition and Technical Rules.
11. Borrowing of boxers from any unit, other than those approved by BFI are strictly prohibited.
12. Persons accompanying the team as Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO / RJ in the championship.
13. No extra member in the team will be allowed.
14. Vaccination certificate of 2 doses or RT-PCR negative report is mandatory. All boxers, team official and technical official coming for the championship are requested to bring 2 doses vaccination certificate or RT-PCR negative report conducted within 72 hours before arrival. During the arrival at the championship temperature will be checked. Anyone having temperature or does not possess negative RT-PCR report, he/she will not be allowed to enter the venue. The RT-PCR tests must be conducted in approved labs with barcode printed on the reports.
15. It is mandatory for everyone to use mask appropriately at all places, except in boxing ring. Covid appropriate behavior is expected from all.
16. Entries will be allowed only to boxers/Coaches/R&J, who have BFI registration number.
