Entry Fee Rs. 1,000/- per team in cash to be paid to BFI's representative at the time

of sports entry check.

Weight Class A team consists of a max. of 12 numbers of boxers (45-48, 48-50, 50-

52, 52-54, 54-57, 57-60, 60-63, 63-66, 66-70, 70-75, 75-81, +81 Kgs.)

Not exceeding One Boxer in each weight class. No reserves will be

allowed.

Competition Format Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, One (1) minute rest between

rounds. IBA's 10 points must scoring system shall be followed. Championship will be conducted as per IBA's AOB Technical &

Competition Rules.

Eligibility Boxers born during the year 1st January, 1982 - 31st December,

2003 are eligible. Entries will be accepted on receipt of Entry by Number & Entry by Name as per the enclosed format and duly signed by the President/Secretary of the affiliated unit of Boxing Federation of India.

All Boxers must have their **Original Birth Certificate**, **Aadhar card & Record Book**. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate and Aadhar card must be submitted at the time of Initial weigh-in and Medical

Examination.

Medical & Weigh-in Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the venue from

0700-0800 hrs for those boxers who are drawn to box on those respective days from 20th December to 26th December 2022. Boxers must present themselves without any body piercing etc. and accessories

are not allowed.

Draw

Draw will be held on 19th December 2022 at 6:00 pm.

Team officials

The participating teams are entitled to bring four (4) coaches & one (1) R/J (IBA/BFI Qualified).

The name of R/J proposed to be sent to may be indicated while sending entry by numbers. After clearance of BFI, the R/J may be deputed.

Dress

Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or shoes minus spikes and without heel, Shorts not exceeding knee length and a Vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the color of the Corner. Where vests and Shorts are of the same color, the Belt line must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waist band 10 Cm wide of contrasting color (White).

Boarding/Lodging

Free Lodging & Boarding will be provided to all boxers and officials by the organizers from 19th December to 27th December before noon.

Arrival particulars

The Organizers will have their reception booth at around railway station/Bhopal Airport/Bus Stand. All teams will be duly received on arrival at the respective Bus stand/ Railway Station upon receipt of prior intimation from the states to the Local Organizing Committee only.

LOC's contact particulars will be circulated for information of all participating teams and other officials conducting the Championship.

Conveyance

Local Transport from Railway Station / Bus Stand to their place of lodging and back will be provided by organizers. Transport will be available for participants and officials to and fro the place of stay to venue of the championship and back.

Additional Guidelines

- 1. Entry will be allowed ONLY to Boxers / Coaches, whose name are in Entry by Name by state association in the prescribed format.
- 2. To and Fro cost of travel to Bhopal and back of the Team / Officials will be the responsibility of respective units.
- 3. The Team / Officials shall not arrive at venue earlier than the 19th December, 2022 and shall leave by noon of 27th December 2022.
- **4.** Boxing Federation of India's/IBA Ring officials representing affiliated units whose names are approved by BFI for officiating in the championship will be allowed.
- 5. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield (not of red or partially red color) Red and Blue vest & shorts or skirts according to their respective corner allocation. Pubic protector and breast protector may be worn if needed.
- **6.** For the first Weigh-in, the Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
- 7. No types of body piercing and body accessories etc. are not allowed to be worn during the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
- **8.** Women are permitted to wear sports hijabs "should they want due to religious reasons" as per IBA guidelines.
- 9. Boxers must carry their Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate or College / Institute Leaving Certificate (SLC) or original copy of Age verified by the School/College or Mark Sheet of 10th /12th standard for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose, along with their Aadhar Card.
- 10. All boxers must carry a recent Hepatitis B, C and HIV test certificate. (within 3 months validity)
- 11. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit BFI's Medical Fitness Certificate. (1 month validity)
- 12. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves, head guards to all the Boxers for their respective bouts. Hand Bandages will be provided as well.
- 13. Adherence of strict discipline will be observed at the place of boarding/lodging and at the venue. Any breach of discipline will result in withdrawal of boarding and lodging arrangements, followed by disciplinary action.
- 14. The Championship will be conducted as per IBA / BFI Competition and Technical Rules.
- 15. Borrowing of boxers from any other unit, other than those approved by BFI is strictly prohibited.
- **16.** Persons accompanying the team as Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO / RJ in the championship.

17. No extra member in the team will be allowed.
