Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, One (1) minute rest between rounds. IBA's 10 points must scoring system shall be followed. Championship will be conducted as per IBA's latest AOB Technical & Competition Rules.

Competition Format

Eligibility	Boxers between the age of 17 and 18 according to their year of birth (between 1 st January, 2005 and 31 st December, 2006) are eligible to participate in the competition. Entries will be accepted on receipt of Entry by Number & Entry by Name as per the enclosed format and duly signed by the President/Secretary of the affiliated unit of Boxing Federation of India.
	All Boxers must have their Original birth Certificate & Record Book. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate must be submitted at the time of weigh-in and Medical Examination.
Medical & Weigh-in	Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the venue daily from 07:00-08:00 hrs <u>ONLY</u> for the boxers drawn to box on those respective days from 13^{th} to 18^{th} June, 2023. Boxer must present themselves clean shaven and no body piercing and accessories at the time of Medical, Weighing in & in bouts.
Draw	: Draw will be held on 12 th June 2023 at 5:00 pm.
Dress	Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or Shoes minus spikes and without heel, Shorts not exceeding knee length and a Vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the colour of the Corner. Where vests and shorts are of the same colour, the Belt line must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waistband 10 Cm wide of White Colour.
Team officials	The participating teams are entitled to bring three (3) coaches, and one (1) R/J (BFI/IBA qualified R&J) will be allowed per Unit/Board. One RJ Name shall be sent with Entry by number.
Boarding/Lodging	Free Boarding and Lodging will be provided to all boxers and officials by the organizers from 12 th June, 2023 (Morning) to 19 th June, 2023 (before noon).
Arrival particulars	The Organizers will have their reception booth at Sikkim National Transport (SNT) Gangtok Bus Stand. All team(s)/official(s) will be duly received on arrival upon receipt of prior intimation from the Units.
Conveyance	Transport will be available for participants and officials to and fro from place of stay in Sikkim to the venue of the championship.
How to Reach Gangtok and Nearest Railway Station/ Airport	Nearest railway station is New Jalpaiguri Station / Siliguri Station from both Railway station shared taxi can be hired and bus ticket can be purchase from Sikkim National Transport (SNT) Bus Stand, Silliguri to reach Gangtok.
	Nearest Airport is Bagdogra Airport and taxi can be hired from Airport or sharing taxi from SNT bus stand is also available for hire. The total distance from New Jalpaiguri Station to Gantok is 110 Kms (4 to 5 Hours).

Important

- 1. To and Fro cost of travel to Gangtok, Sikkim and back of the Team / Officials will be the responsibility of respective units.
- 2. The Team / Officials shall not arrive at venue earlier than the 12th June, 2023 and shall leave by19th June, 2023 by noon. No boarding & Lodging will be provided before 12th June 2023.
- 3. Boxing Federation of India/IBA qualified Ring officials representing affiliated units must bring a nomination letter from their respective units President / Secretary intimating that they have been nominated as Ring official.
- 4. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield (not of red or partially red color) Red & Blue Vest & Shorts according to their respective corner allocation.)
- 5. The Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor be below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
- 6. Boxers must be clean shaven and no type of body piercing and body accessories are allowed to be wornduring the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
- Boxers must carry their Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate or School Leaving Certificate (SLC) or Original copy of Age verified by the School on their letter head or Mark Sheet of 10th /12th standard for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose, along with Aadhar Card.
- 8. "Age Estimation Certificate" for all participating Boxers conducted at a Government Hospital as per SAI norms is needed to be submitted during Medicals.
- 9. All boxers must carry a recent Hepatitis B, C and HIV test certificate.
- 10. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit Annual Medical Fitness Certificate as per IBA.
- 11. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves and Head Guards to all the Boxers for their respective bouts. Hand Bandages will be provided as well.
- 12. Adherence of strict discipline will be observed at the place of boarding/lodging and at the venue. Any breach of discipline will result in withdrawal of boarding and lodging arrangements, followed by disciplinary action.
- 13. The Championship will be conducted as per IBA / BFI AOB Competition and Technical Rules.
- 14. Borrowing of boxers from any other unit, other than those approved by BFI is strictly prohibited.
- 15. Persons accompanying the team as Manager and / or Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO /RJ in the championship.
- 16. No extra member in the team will be allowed.
- 17. Entry will be allowed ONLY to Boxers / Coaches / R&J's who have BFI Registration Number.
- 18. Any Medical emergency and hospitalization of Boxers, RJ & Official will be borne by Host.
