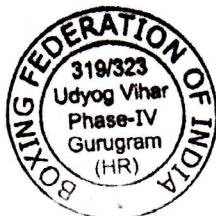

**Chairman (Commissions) :** The Chairman of Commissions of Boxing Federation of India were also present in the Meeting.

**Agenda Item No. 1 : Welcome address by President**

Mr. Ajay Singh, President, Boxing Federation of India extended warm welcome to everyone.

President stated that BFI is going all out towards preparation for Olympic 2024. It will be our endeavor to win more Medals in the Olympic 2024.

Indian Youth Men's & Women's and Junior Girl's & Boy's Boxing Team participated in the ASBC Boxing Championships held at Amman, Jordan from 27<sup>th</sup> February to 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 and the Indian Team won highest medal tally (39 Medals) for the country. Ms. Mahi Raghav was judge as best boxer in the said championship. A proud moment for India and BFI. President reiterated the importance of Grassroots development through conduct of the National Championships at Sub Junior Level in 2022.

President stated that we need recruitment of Foreign Coach for Elite Men & Women Boxing Team and Support Staff for the National Boxing Coaching Camps and asked members for any suggestions. No suggestions were received.

President also stated that Course for RJ and ITOs were not conducted due to Covid -19 in India for the development of Boxing during 2021.

ACTC Budget for the year 2022-2023 was approved for Rs. 24.Crores, boxing being high priority sport for the Government of India.

We are planning to work on Boxing League by the end of year and we will have next version for new Boxing League including Fight Nights. Due to Covid -19, we could not plan to work on this, President stated that BFI is fully committed to conduct this event.

SG, BFI congratulated Mr. Ajay Singh for the extraordinary performance of our Youth & Junior Boxing Team, who won highest medals in the championships.

SG stated for the confirmation of Minutes of 17<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Executive Council held on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. The minutes were unanimously approved. Proposed by Mr. Anil Kumar Bohidar and seconded by Mr. Narendra Kumar Nirwan

**Agenda Item No. 2 : Confirmation of the Minutes of previous Meeting.**

**Agenda Item No. 4 : Consideration and passing of the Audited Statement of Accounts submitted by the Honorary Treasurer for the year 2022-23.**

The Audited Account and Budget were discussed and approved by Mr. Fateh Singh Rathore and seconded by Mr. R. Gopu.

**Agenda Item No. 5 : Budget Estimate for the year 2022-23**

Budget Estimate for the year 2022-23 was discussed / approved and proposed by Mr. Santosh Dutta and seconded by Mr. Narendra Kumar Nirwan.

**Agenda Item No. 6 : Appointment of Auditor 2022-23**

For the appointment of Auditor for the year 2022-23, Mr. Digvijay Singh recommended the name of M/s. Manish Goel & Associates for the year 2022-23. It was approved, proposed by Mr. Rajesh Bhandari and seconded by Mr. Anil Kumar Bohidar.

**Agenda Item No. 7 : Correction to amendment of BFI MoA&RR that was incorporated on 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2020.**

President, BFI thanked all members who worked on the amendment of Constitution of BFI.

Certain changes had been proposed by the Government for amendment of MoA&RR of BFI. The changes were made in the MoA&RR in line with NSDC - 2011 and it was decided in the EC Meeting and amendments were made in the meeting of 19<sup>th</sup> Executive Council held on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. Members of AGM unanimously approved the MoA& RR of BFI.



**Agenda Item No. 8 : Consideration of the Calendar for various National Championships for the year 2022.**

Nagaland Amateur Boxing Association was agreed to conduct the Junior National Boxing Championship. President, BFI stated that we would be delighted to host this championship in Nagaland.

For Nagaland advised to them Bid for National Boxing Championships were awarded to the following state units and they have already been conducted successfully :

1. JSW, ISS, Bellary have requested to BFI for the conduct of Sub-Junior Boy's & Girl's National Boxing Championship in the month of May, 2022. The National Boxing Championships for Sub-Junior Boy's & Girl's was conducted successfully at Inspire Institute of Sports, Ballary Karnataka from 19<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.
2. Tamil Nadu Boxing Association had bid to conduct the 5<sup>th</sup> Youth Men's & Women's National Boxing Championships. The championships conducted successfully at SRM Univeristy, Kattankulathur, Chennai from 06<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. For Youth Men, total 31 States / boards participated with the strength of 318 boxer and in the Youth Women, 30 states were participated with the strength of 228 boxer.
3. Manipur Amateur Boxing Association had bid to conduct the 5<sup>th</sup> Junior Girl's National Boxing Championship. The National Championship was conducted successfully at Manipur from 27<sup>th</sup> October to 02<sup>nd</sup> November, 2022.
4. The 4<sup>th</sup> Junior Boy's National Boxing Championship was awarded to Boxing Association of Bihar. The National Championship was conducted successfully at Patilputra Sports Complex, Patna, Bihar from 17<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2022.
5. M.P. Amateur Boxing Association had bid to conduct the 6<sup>th</sup> Elite Women's National Boxing Championship in collaboration with M. P. Government. The championship was successfully conducted at Tanya Tope Stadium, Madhya Pradesh from 19<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.
6. Haryana Boxing Sangh had bid to conduct the 6<sup>th</sup> Elite Men's National Boxing Championship. The National Boxing Championship was conducted successfully at Hisar, Haryana from 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022 to 06<sup>th</sup> January, 2023.





**Agenda Item No. 9 : Matter relating to Disciplinary Committee and pending issues of various states.**

Matters related to Disciplinary Committee are as follows :

1. Issues were raised by Mr. Rohit Jain for UPBA. SG stated that there were a lot of complaints against UPBA. Their elections were overdue even when BFI had asked to conduct the election in time. UPBA failed to produce documents to BFI. It was decided in the EC Meeting to constitute an Adhoc Committee for U.P. Amateur Boxing Association. The Adhoc Committee was constituted Dr. D. P. Bhatt as Chairman.
2. Matter of Tamil Nadu Boxing Association was sent to Chairman Adhoc Committee, Mr. Hemanta Kumar Kalita to resolve the issues.
3. Telangana, West Bengal and Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman Diu. President advised to SG, BFI to resolve the issues before the next meeting.

Matters of Mr. Jay Kowli was discussed in the house and President stated that all the records related to Mr. Jay Kowli should be kept in records and the matter also to be sent to Disciplinary Committee.

**Agenda Item No. 10 : Any other matter with the permission of Chair.**
