







REC Open Talent Hunt-2 Programme Elite (Men & Women) and Youth (Men & Women) - 2024

Introduction

Boxing Federation of India in association with Rural Electrification Corporation & Sports Authority of India is conducting the 2 REC Open Talent Hunt-1 & 2 and 1 Combined National Level Talent Hunt Programmes for the holistic development of Elite & Youth Boxers in the country. The aim of this Open Talent Hunt Programme is to identify and help recognize the talent at the Elite and Youth levels in the country.

Selection for Elite National Coaching Camp:

Gold and Silver Medalist of Elite Men & Women in Combined REC Talent Hunt will get a chance to part of National Coaching Camp.

Selection for Youth National Championship:-

Gold and Silver Medalist of Youth Men & Women in Combined REC Talent Hunt will be selected to participate in the National Championships.

Format of REC Open Talent Hunt Programme

Elite Men / Women: From each Talent Hunt Men -12 x 4 = 48 boxers, Women 12 x 4 = 48 boxers in each Group will be selected for the REC Talent Hunt Programme. Thus, the total number of boxers so selected will be 96 (12 x 4 x 2) Men Boxers & 96 (12 x 4 x 2) Women Boxers.

Youth Men / **Women** From each Talent Hunt Men -10 x 4 = 40 boxers, Women 10 x 4 = 40 boxers in each Group will be selected for the REC Talent Hunt Programme. Thus, the total number of boxers so selected will be **80** (10 x 4 x 2) Men Boxers & **80** (10 x 4 x 2) Women Boxers.

Format of REC Open Talent Hunt Programme

On this basis about 96 Elite Men Boxers & 80 Youth Men Boxers and 96 Elite Women and 80 Youth Women boxers will be eligible to participate in the Combined National Level Talent Programme. In the REC Talent Hunt Programme, the bouts will be held on knock-out basis. During the REC National Open Talent Hunt Programme, Scholarships will also be given according to the merit.

If a boxer has come in the top 4 ranking in Talent Hunt-1 of the REC Open Talent Hunt Programme, then, that boxer will not be eligible to participate in the Talent Hunt-2. If there is a violation to this rule, he/she will be disqualified.

Eligibility for Elite Men &

Elite Women Boxers born during the year 1st January, 1984 - 31st December,

2005 are eligible.

Eligibility for Youth Men &

Youth Women Boxers born during the year 1st January, 2006 - 31st December,

2007 are eligible.

Entries will be accepted only after the registration on the given link.

All Boxers must have their Original birth Certificate, Aadhar card & Medical Book. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate and Aadhar card must be submitted at the time of Initial weigh-in and medical examination. All boxers must comply before registration, with an age verification test report as per NCAFS norms and formats.

Medical & Weigh-in Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the

venue from 0600-0700 hrs. <u>for those boxers who are drawn to box on</u> the respective days from 15th September to 21st September, 2024.

Draw will be held on 14th September, 2024 at 5:00 pm.

Team officialsThe participating teams are entitled to bring three (3) coaches at their

own expense.

Dress Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or shoes minus spikes and

without heels, shorts not exceeding knee length, and a vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the color of the Corner. Where vests and Shorts are of the same color, the Beltline must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waistband 10 Cm

wide of contrasting color.

Boarding/Lodging (For Boxers

And coaches) All the boxers & coaches have to manage their own Lodging &

Boarding.

Boarding/Lodging (For Technical

Officials)

Technical Officials are only entitled to the Boarding and Lodging

from Host.

Arrival particular All the boxers & Team Officials have to manage their own

transportation. To & Fro to the place of stay to the competition venue.

Conveyance Transport will only be available for Technical officials to and fro the

place of stay to the venue of the Programme and back.

Registration The entry will be done by boxer himself / herself by visiting the given

registration link.

NTO & RJ's NTO's and RJ's will be appointed by Boxing Federation of India

Additional Guidelines

- 1. To and Fro cost of travel to Guwahati and back as well as place of stay to competition venue of the Team / Team Officials will be the responsibility of Individuals.
- 2. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield (not of red or partially red color) Red and Blue vest & shorts or skirts according to their respective corner allocation. For women boxers pubic protectors and breast protectors may be worn if needed.
- 3. For the first Weigh-in, the Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor be below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
- 4. No type of body piercing and body accessories is not allowed to be worn during the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
- Boxers must carry their Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate, Aadhar Card and Original copy of Age Verification Report from the School for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose.
- 6. "Age Estimation Certificate" for all participating boxers conducted at a Government Hospital as per SAI Norms is needed to be submitted during medical examination.
- 7. All boxers must carry a recent Hepatitis B, C and HIV test certificate. (last 3 months validity)
- 8. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit BFI's **Annual Medical Fitness Certificate** as per World Boxing (With Last 3 month validity)
- 9. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves, head guards and hand bandages to all the boxers for their respective bouts.
- 10. The Programme will be conducted as per World Boxing / BFI Competition and Technical Rules.
- 11. Borrowing of boxers from any unit, other than those approved by BFI are strictly prohibited.
- 12. Persons accompanying the team as Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO / RJ in the Programme.
- 13. Entries will be allowed only to boxers/Coaches/R&J, who have BFI registration number.
- 14. Women are permitted to wear sports hijabs "should they want due to religious reasons" as per World Boxing guidelines.
- 15. Boxers from any Region can participate in REC Open Talent Hunt Programmes 1 & 2.
- 16. If a boxer has come in the top 4 ranking in any Region of the REC Open Talent Hunt Programme, then, that boxer will not be eligible to participate from any other Talent Hunt, if there is a violation to this rule, he/she will be disqualified.
