	Entries will be selected from the Top 8 boxers entered in the Preliminary Entry List, according to the Official World Boxing Ranking Points. If the Host National Federation (India) does not have a boxer ranked in the Top 8, then the Top 7 ranked boxers plus 1 Host Nation Quota Entry will be selected.	
The Host National Federation (India) will have 1 Quota Entry per each We Category. (20)		
Example: If the top 8 boxers from the World Boxing Ranking Points (Including I enter the World Boxing Cup Finals, all 8 will be selected.		
	If one boxer does not enter from the Top 8 Ranking Points, the entry will be offered to the next ranked boxer that has entered on the Preliminary Entries List.

5. ENTRY PROCESS

- Each participating National Federation must confirm that all boxers and Team Members meet the required technical and medical standards.
- National Federations are responsible for:
 - Submitting personal data for every Team Member
 - o Ensuring that all submitted information is accurate and up to date

At this time, the entry process for Teams is completed via email, as specified below:

Technical Officials:

World Boxing will appoint Technical Officials, Referees and Judges via a random draw selection process for this competition.

Withdrawals after the final entry deadline will not be refunded.

5.1 Accompanying Team Members

The total number of Team Officials that may be accredited per NF depends on the number of competing Boxers.

Each Team may include the following accredited Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor (must be registered within their NOC/NF)
- 1 Physiotherapist











- 1 Dietitian/Nutritionist
- Coaches with ringside access:

1-3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches
4-8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches
9-20 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches

National Federations wishing to register media representatives, including photographers and videographers, are kindly requested to contact media@exceedboxing.com.

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that all Team Members are qualified to perform their duties.

5.2 Sport Entries Check

The Sport Entries check is the final part of the event entry process and it will take place on 14 + 15 November 2025 at the Team's Hotel. World Boxing and the OrgCom will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event as well as it will be displayed on the Teams information board.

The Sport Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive on time for their respective appointment.

Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Sport Entries check (e.g. Team Manager and the Team Doctor).

In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Athletes Passport
- Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Medical Certificate issued within the previous three months, signed by the National Federation Doctor
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (women boxers only), signed by the boxer/legal guardian
- Uniforms (red and blue) per World Boxing Competition Rules
- Signed Conditions of Participation Form for each Team Member (If form not previously submitted online)
- Certificate of Gender Test (Women boxers only)
- Signed World Boxing Code of Conduct (If form not previously submitted online)

To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditation, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs with the OrgCom.

Important: Failure to attend the Sport Entries Check per the scheduled appointment by any Team will lead to the exclusion of the entire Team from taking part in the event with all accommodation and fees payable to the OrgCom forfeit.











6. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

OrgCom will provide assistance to participating Teams requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition.

All participants (athletes, coaches, officials) must apply for a **Business Visa for Sports Persons** through their nearest Indian Embassy or Consulate. Visa issuance requires prior clearances from the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Ministry of Home Affairs, and Ministry of External Affairs, which will be facilitated by the Boxing Federation of India.

For information and visa support letters, please reach out to the Boxing Federation of India at info@boxingfederation.in. The deadline to submit requests for visa support letters is 20 October 2025. Please allow at least three (3) weeks for visa processing after submission of all required documents to the Indian authorities.

Passports of all participants must be valid for at least **six (6) months** from the date of arrival in India and contain at least **two blank pages** for visas and stamps.

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that their Team respects the conditions of stay defined by the Government of India. Any costs arising from noncompliance will be borne by the respective National Federation.

7. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The designated airport for arrival and departure of Teams is **Indira Gandhi International Airport** (DEL) - https://www.newdelhiairport.in.

All Teams must submit their arrival and departure details to the OrgCom via info@boxingfederation.in by 31 October 2025 (23:59 CET).

Official arrival transportation will be available on 15-16 November 2025, and official departure transportation will be available on 21 November 2025.

8. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The OrgCom will provide airport transfers between Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) and official hotels for Teams on official arrival and departure days.

Daily transport between official hotels and the competition venue will be provided during the











event period according to a published schedule.

This service is only available to Teams staying in official hotels booked through the OrgCom. If Teams are using an unofficial hotel, or an official hotel not reserved through the OrgCom, they are not entitled to use official event transportation.

Additional transportation costs will apply for airport transfers or any other transportation required outside of official event days; costs will be provided upon request.

Guidance information and transport timetables will be displayed on event information boards in the lobby of the Event Hotel.

11. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

The OrgCom will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All training











sessions will be open to the accredited media unless a Team specifically requests otherwise. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to World Boxing and the OrgCom.

Video recording of bouts for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may only record bouts of their boxers using one camera per ring if for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose. Each National Federation must submit a signed copy of Video Recording Disclaimer at the Technical Meeting to the World Boxing Competition Manager.

12. MEDICAL SERVICES

The OrgCom will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

13. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during World Boxing Competitions. Full compliance is expected from boxers and their entourage and any violation of the World Anti-Doping Code may result in sanctions.

14. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.




