Entry Fee	Rs. 1,000/- in cash to be paid to BFI's representative for State Unit and Rs. 3000 for Boards
Weight Class	A team may consist of a maximum of 10 boxers for Men & 10 Boxers for Women. Only one entry per weight category will be permitted. U-19 Men Weight Category: 47-50kg, 50-55kg, 55-60kg, 60-65kg, 65-70kg, 70-75kg 75-80kg, 80-85kg, 85-90kg & +90kg. U-19 Women Weight Category: 45-48kg, 48-51kg, 51-54kg, 54-57kg, 57-60kg, 60-65kg, 65-70kg, 70-75kg, 75-80kg & +80kg.
	No reserves are allowed.
Competition Format	Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, One (1) minute rest between rounds. 10 points must score system shall be followed. Championship will be conducted as Per World Boxing Competition Rules and Regulation

Eligibility

Boxers between the age of 17 and 18 according to their year of birth (between 1st January, 2008 and 31st December, 2009) are eligible to participate in the competition. Entries will be accepted on receipt of Entry by Number & Entry by Name as per the enclosed format and duly signed by the President/Secretary of the affiliated unit of Boxing Federation of India.

All Boxers must have their original birth Certificate & Record Book. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate must be submitted at the time of weigh-in and Medical Examination.

Medical & Weigh-in

Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the venue daily from 07:00-08:00 hrs **ONLY** for the boxers drawn to box on those respective days from 13th April to 19th April 2026. Boxer must present themselves without body piercing etc and accessories are not allowed.

Draw

: Draw will be held on 12th April 2026 at 5:00 pm.

Dress

Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or Shoes minus spikes and without heel, Shorts not exceeding knee length and a Vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the colour of the Corner. Where vests and shorts are of the same colour, the Belt line must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waistband 10 Cm wide of White Colour.

Team officials

The participating teams are entitled to bring three (3) coaches for Men Team and three (3) Coaches for Women Team.

Referee & Judges

All Referee & Judges will be nominated by ROC commission of Boxing Federation of India. State Unit/boards are requested not to send RJ's with the team.

Boarding/Lodging

Free Boarding and Lodging will be provided to all boxers and officials by the organizers from 12th April, 2026 (Morning) to 20th April 2026 (before noon).

Arrival particulars

The Organizers will have their reception booth at Guwahati Railway Station. All team(s)/official(s) will be duly received on arrival upon receipt of prior intimation from the Units.

Conveyance

Local conveyance from Railway Station to their place of lodging and back will be provided by organizers. Transport will be available for participants and officials to and fro from place of stay to the venue of the championship and back.

Important

1. To and Fro cost of travel to Guwahati, Assam and back of the Team / Officials will be the responsibility of respective units.
2. The Team / Officials shall not arrive at venue earlier than the 12th April 2026 and shall leave by 20th April 2026 by noon. No boarding & Lodging will be provided before 11th April 2026.
3. All boxers must possess their own Gum shield. Red & Blue Vest & Shorts according to their respective corner allocation.) Pubic protector or breast protector may be worn if needed. Accommodation for Boxers will be provided in Don Bosco University.
4. The Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor be below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
5. No type of body piercing and body accessories are allowed to be worn during the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
6. Women are permitted to wear sports hijab 'should they want to due to religious reason' as per World Boxing Rules.
7. Boxers must carry their Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate or School Leaving Certificate (SLC) or Original copy of Age verified by the School on their letter head or Mark Sheet of 10th /12th standard for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose, along with Aadhar Card.
8. **"Age Estimation Certificate"** for all participating Boxers conducted at a **Government Hospital as per SAI norms** is needed to be submitted during Medicals.
9. All boxers must carry a recent **Hepatitis B, C and HIV** test certificate. (Last 3 Month Validity)
10. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit Medical Fitness Certificate. (Last 3 Month Validity)
11. All Boxers must carry their **Aadhar History, it will be checked during sports entry check.**
12. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves and Head Guards to all the Boxers for their respective bouts. Hand Bandages will be provided as well.
13. Adherence of strict discipline will be observed at the place of boarding/lodging and at the venue. Any breach of discipline will result in withdrawal of boarding and lodging arrangements, followed by disciplinary action.
14. The Championship will be conducted as per World Boxing / BFI AOB Competition and Technical Rules.
15. Every team shall deposit Rs. 3,000/- as security deposit for accommodation and the same will be refunded after safe return of properties and facilities provided by the Organizer.
16. Borrowing of boxers from any other unit, other than those approved by BFI is strictly prohibited.
17. Persons accompanying the team as Manager and / or Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO /RJ in the championship.
18. No extra member in the team will be allowed.
19. **Entry will be allowed ONLY to Boxers / Coaches / R&J's who have BFI Registration Number.**
