World Boxing Cup Finals – Selection Guidelines

In reference to the BFI Selection Policy 2025-26 -Dated 5th January 2025 certain amendments have been made based on the communication received from World Boxing, the **World Boxing Cup Finals will be a quota event and will be held strictly by invitation.**

- The **Top 8 ranked boxers** in each weight category will be invited to participate in the World Boxing Cup Finals in India.
- As the host country, **India will receive a host quota** in any weight category where no Indian boxer is ranked in the Top 8.
 - In such cases, the Top 7 ranked boxers will qualify, and the 8th place will be **reserved for an Indian boxer (host quota).**

Selection Process for Indian Boxers

- In weight categories where an Indian boxer is already in the **Top 8 by name (ranking points)**, that boxer will directly qualify for the World Boxing Cup Finals.
- For weight categories where India is allotted a **host quota**, the entry will be decided through a **Ranking Evaluation at the National Coaching Camp (NCC).**



Ranking Evaluation Format (NCC)

1. NCC Rank 3 and Rank 4 will first be evaluated with the **BFI Cup 2025 Gold and Silver medallists**.
 - From this, the **Top 2** will move forward to join **NCC Rank 1 and Rank 2** and Bottom 2 will be Excluded from the camp.
2. These four boxers will then be evaluated for Rank 1 to Rank 4. Out of these boxers will be selected and registered as below:-

Rank 1 → Main Entry for World Boxing Cup Finals.

Rank 2 → Reserve Entry for World Boxing Cup Finals.

Note:

- In weight categories where an Indian boxer is already in the **Top 8 (by World Boxing ranking points)**, that boxer will go directly to the World Boxing Cup Finals.
- In such cases, the evaluation will only be conducted to **prune the camp size and determine internal camp rankings**.(Rank 2 to Rank 4)
- The qualified boxer will be exempted to participate in this evaluation.
