Teams Participation

Each affiliated State/UT Association and Board of the Boxing Federation of India (BFI) shall be entitled to one (1) direct entry in each weight category. In addition, each Sports Authority of India (SAI) National Centre of Excellence (NCOE) shall also be entitled to one (1) direct entry in each weight category.

Further, any boxer who fulfils any of the following eligibility criteria may also be entered, over and above the direct entries:

1. Medal winner from any of the last two editions of the BFI 8th & 9th Elite Men & Women National Boxing Championships.
2. Gold & Silver Medallist from any Elite State Championship conducted during the last two years by affiliated Unit of Boxing Federation of India.

There shall be no restriction on the number of entries in any weight category from a State/UT Association, Board, or SAI NCOE, provided the additional boxers satisfy the above eligibility criteria.

All entries from affiliated State/UT Associations must be submitted through the respective President or Secretary of the concerned State/UT Association.

Competition Format

Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, One (1) minute rest between rounds. 10 points must scoring system shall be followed. Championship will be conducted as per World Boxing Technical & Competition Rules.

Eligibility

Boxers born during the year (1st January 1986 to 31st December 2007 are eligible). Entries will be accepted on receipt of Entry by Number & Entry by Name as per the enclosed format and duly signed by the President/ Secretary of the affiliated unit of Boxing Federation of India.

All Boxers must have their Original Birth Certificate, Aadhar card & Record Book. Photocopy of the original Birth Certificate and Aadhar card must be submitted at the time of Initial weigh-in and Medical Examination.

Medical & Weigh-in

Daily weigh-in and medical examination will be held at the venue from 0700-0800 hrs for those boxers who are drawn to box on those respective days from 17th Aug to 23 Aug 2026. Boxers must present themselves without any body piercing and any accessories are not allowed.

Draw

Draw will be held on 16th August 2026 at 5:00pm.

Team officials

The participating teams are entitled to bring upto three (3) coaches for Men & 3 Coaches for Women. Boxing Federation of India will nominate the referee & judges for this Tournament.

Dress

Competitors shall Box in Boxing shoes or Shoes without spikes and without heel, Shorts not exceeding knee length and a Vest covering the chest and back. Boxers shall wear a Red & Blue Vest depending on the colour of the Corner. Where vests and

Shorts are of the same colour, the Belt line must be clearly indicated by using an elastic waist band 5 – 10 cm wide of contrasting color.

Boarding/Lodging

Free boarding and lodging arrangements will be provided by Organizers to Boxers, Team Coaches, NTO and Referee & Judges.

Conveyance

The cost of travel to and from Nahan, Himachal Pradesh, shall be borne by the respective participating units/Boards/NCOE.

Additional Guidelines

1. **Entry will be allowed ONLY to Boxers/ Coaches who have BFI Registration Number. NSRS ID is also mandatory for Participation.**
2. The cost of travel to and from Nahan, Himachal Pradesh of the Team/ Team Officials shall be borne by respective units/boards/NCOE's.
3. No team or official shall arrive at the venue before 16 August 2026 and must depart by noon on 24 August 2026.
4. All men boxers shall carry their own gumshield (any colour), centre guard and may wear a jockstrap. All women shall carry their own gumshield and red and blue competition vests and shorts/skirts according to their allocated corner. A breast protector and pubic protector may be worn, if required.
5. For the first Weigh-in, the Boxer's weight should not exceed the maximum of the Boxer's weight class nor be below the minimum of the Boxer's weight class. However, for daily Weigh-in Boxer need to maintain his weight so as not to exceed upper limit of weight class.
6. Any type of body piercing and body accessories are not allowed to be worn during the bout and Medical Examination & Weighing In.
7. Boxers must carry their Record Book. They should also carry their original Municipal Birth Certificate or College / Institute Leaving Certificate (SLC) or original copy of Age verified by the School/College or Mark Sheet of 10th /12th standard for Boxing Federation of India's registration purpose, along with their Aadhar Card
8. All boxers must carry a recent Hepatitis B, C and HIV test certificate. (last 3 Months validity)
9. All participating Boxers and RJ's also need to submit BFI's Medical Fitness Certificate. (Last 3 Months validity).
10. The Organizing Committee will provide Boxing gloves to all the Boxers for their respective bouts. Hand Bandages will be provided as well.
11. Adherence of strict discipline will be observed at the place of boarding/lodging and at the venue. Any breach of discipline will result in withdrawal of boarding and lodging arrangements, followed by disciplinary action.
12. The Championship will be conducted as per World Boxing / BFI Competition and Technical Rules.
13. Borrowing of boxers from any other unit, other than those approved by BFI is strictly prohibited.
14. Persons accompanying the team as Manager and / or Coach will not be permitted to officiate as TO / RJ in the championship.
15. Entries will be allowed only for boxers and coaches possessing a valid BFI Registration Number and NSRS ID.
